Additionally, she was known for her dancing abilities and her love for singing. No matter where she was, she was always ready to put on a show and sing the songs she loved. Furthermore, she was considered the "family comedian," she loved to tease, and kept everyone around her laughing and smiling.

Michelle's Christian journey began at an early age, she attended Sunday School and Vacation Bible School at Varick Memorial AME Zion Church in River Terrace. As a young adult, she joined From the Heart Church Ministries_® where she received foundational teachings. She was later called into ministry at the Temple of the Living God Worldwide Deliverance Ministries. Michelle was very dedicated to her Pastor and church family.
