# OBITUARY

**Robert Louis Johnson, III** was born on February 3, 1994 in Silver Spring, Maryland. He was the eldest son of Yvette and Robert Louis Johnson, II.

Robert loved music. He started playing music at a young age. Growing up, he played numerous instruments, some of which were self-taught, such as the bass, alto and baritone saxophones, bassoon, guitar, and piano. He also listened to various genres of music, including jazz, rock and roll, gospel, R&B, and hip-hop. As a member of the DC Youth Orchestra, he played at the Kennedy Center. He also had a deep passion for chemistry, math, and other art forms.

Robert gave his heart to the Lord Jesus Christ at From the Heart Church Ministries. He also attended From the Heart Christian School from K-3 until fourth grade and was a member in his youth. He graduated with honors from Paint Branch High School in 2012. While in high school, he was in the marching band and eventually served as a drum major. Additionally, he wrote musical arrangements, started a band with a small group of friends, and influenced his younger brother to start playing the drums.

Robert graduated from Morehouse College in 2016 with a bachelor's degree in Spanish. At Morehouse, he played the trombone and tuba in the marching band. After graduation, he traveled to Costa Rica to continue his studies in a language immersion program. After college, he returned home and attended Omega Recording Studios to learn audio engineering. Robert loved to produce music for clients and his family.

Moreover, he worked at Encore Global for many years, where he began as an audio-visual technician and advanced to an inventory control specialist. He recently took on the role of warehouse manager for Bethesda Systems, LLC, in July of 2024.

In June 2019, he met the love of his life, Whynter Jacqueline. On July 15, 2023, Robert proposed, and on September 7, 2024, they had a lovely mini-mony before their immediate family. He was the proud father of three children: Olivia Skai, Robert Louis, IV and Roman Lucas.

Robert had a big heart, and he will be sorely missed by all who knew and loved him.
