OBITUARY

Joseph Manford Campbell, Jr. was born in Charles County, Maryland to the late Joseph Manford Campbell, Sr. and Wavie Mae Scott. He was raised in Oxon Hill, MD where he became a volunteer firefighter after graduating from Oxon Hill High School. He later joined the police force and served as a MPDC Police Officer for 14 years. He opened a used car dealership, 414 Auto Center, in Temple Hills, MD, where he employed his family and often allowed his children to help out and earn money.

Joseph married Dianne Campbell on September 5, 1998, and remained a husband until his passing. They joined From the Heart Church Ministries in April 2009, and he would say that was the “best decision he’d ever made.” He loved his church and would respond to almost anything with “I’m JC boy!” JC having a double meaning, standing for his father, Joseph Campbell, and his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Joseph was known to friends as “Soup” and to family as “Junior.” You would often hear him refer to himself as “a boss” or “a soldier.” He loved to have a good laugh, play around, and eat good food with his family and friends. Seeing him dancing while snapping his fingers or air boxing were common sights. To see him was validation that a time was to be had.

Spending quality time with his loved ones also included helping when he could. He enjoyed giving a ride to others and supplying food for a feast. His ear was open to the issues of his people and his mouth was surely going to provide a resolution whether it was requested or not. Joseph was strongly opinionated but soft-hearted. After a disagreement he would be the first to get over it, apologize, and annoy the other party until they’re laughing again.

Joseph leaves to cherish his memory his wife, Dianne Campbell; three sons: Dorian Wilson, Cory Moore, Jovohnny Lewis; one daughter: Breona Wilson; one grandson: Dorian Wilson; two brothers: Irvin Edelen and Eric Scott; seven sisters: Ellen Wilson (Mark), Christine Campbell, Phyllis Plater (Joseph), Charlene Campbell, Denisha Toyne, Charlene Scott, and Christine Scott; and many nieces, nephews, cousins, aunts and uncles.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Joseph Manford Campbell, Sr. and Wavie Mae Scott.

My mind is at ease, my soul is at rest

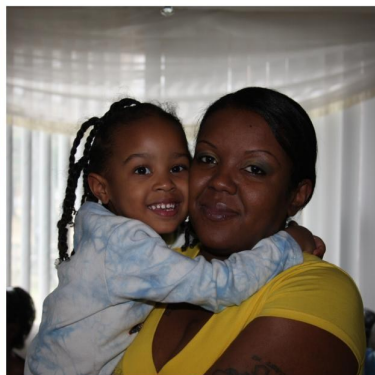
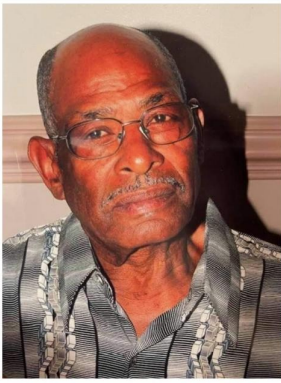
