After more than 81 years of life, **Ella Louise Manning Jones** peacefully transitioned to her heavenly home on January 14, 2025.

Ella was born on February 22, 1943, to the late Joseph William Manning, Sr., and Louise Smith. She was the second of three children.

She was educated in the District of Columbia Public Schools, namely George Bell Elementary, Jefferson Junior High and Coolidge High Schools. Most of Ella's childhood was spent in Southwest Washington, D.C. However, like many in the late 50s, during the initial redevelopment of the Southwest quadrant, the Manning family relocated to Northwest D.C.

In 1960, shortly after graduating high school, she began her employment career with the U.S. Department of Education as a computer specialist. Ella retired from the federal government in 1994.

While employed with the government, Ella met a young Marine named Timothy Allen Jones; they were married on November 21, 1964, in Washington, D.C. Three sons were born from their union: Timothy Jr., and twins Keith and Kevin.

Ella enjoyed reading and sharing the knowledge acquired with others. She also loved fishing and getting on the road to travel and explore. Those were her favorite and fun things to do with her husband, Tim, and their sons. Fun with her family gave her peace and joy. She loved her family and was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, daughter, sister, cousin and friend.

She received her spiritual upbringing at Friendship Baptist and Zion Baptist Churches, in Southwest Washington, D.C. In April 1955, Ella age 12 was baptized at Zion Baptist accepting Christ as her Lord and Savior. In 1997, she joined From the Heart Church Ministries in Suitland, Maryland. She was a longtime member of the church who served in the Office Support Ministry.

Ella will be dearly missed by all who knew and loved her. She leaves to cherish her memories, her husband Timothy Sr.; sons, Kevin and Keith; granddaughter, Destenee Nicole Jones; great-grandchildren, Nyzer Allen and Ny'arri Boswell; sister, Mildred P. Manning; brother, Joseph W. Manning (Marlene); and a host of other relatives and friends.

Ella was preceded in death by her eldest son, Timothy Jones, Jr.
