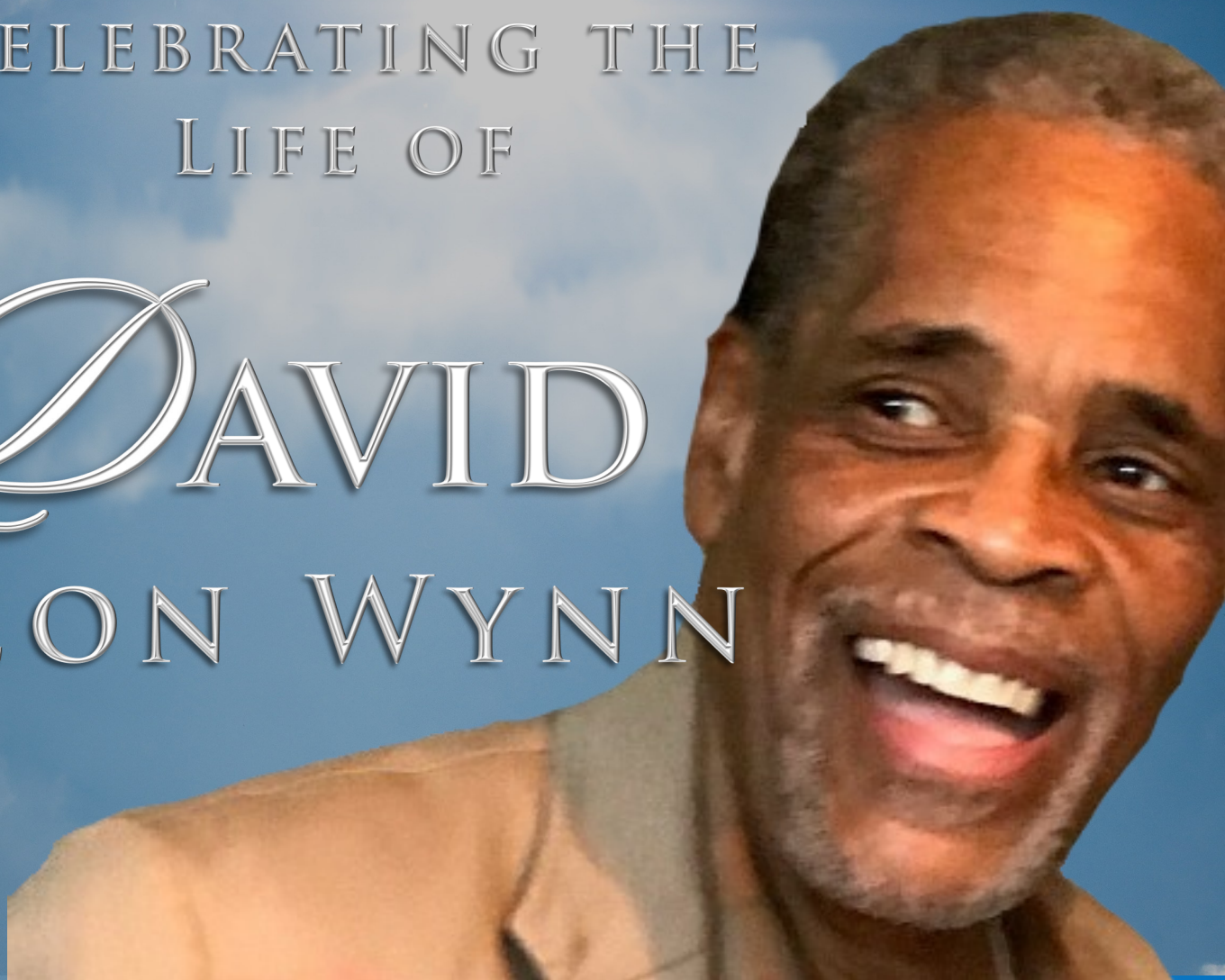

OBITUARY

David Leon Wynn was born to Robert Jones, Jr. and Pearl Olivia Wynn-Jones on October 7, 1951, in Washington, D.C.

David grew up in Washington, D.C. He attended the District of Columbia Public Schools and graduated from Cardozo Senior High School in 1969.

He began his professional career in the jewelry business and later moved to the Federal Government, where he retired from the Department of Justice after 35 years of service.

David gave his life to Jesus Christ at an early age at his family's home church, John Stewart United Methodist Church in D.C. He later joined From the Heart Church Ministries in 1989 and faithfully served in the Adult Choir, the Men's Choir and the Ministry of Knowledge. David also regularly attended Men's Fellowships and Men's Retreats.

He was a dedicated Washington Commanders fan, and on game days, he and his friends served as unofficial sports commentators and engaged in lively phone conversations, critiquing the plays, and celebrating touchdowns.

David enjoyed swimming, playing chess, tennis, and family gatherings at Haines Point. His favorite television show was Jeopardy, during which a "quiet time" was initiated in the Wynn household from 7:30- 8:00 p.m.

His greatest joy; however, was spending time with his granddaughter, Cicely Ayana Wynn, whom he loved to spoil - a perfect excuse for him to indulge in some treats for himself.

David will be dearly missed by all who knew and loved him. He leaves to cherish his memory his son David Leon Wynn, Jr.; daughter, Kapria Ayana Wynn; granddaughter, Cicely Ayana Wynn; sisters: Karlytta Wynn, Carolyn Baker (Louis), Deitra Jones, Shelia Jones, Yvette Wynn; brother, Sterling Mahoney; brother-in-law, Bruce Sharp, Sr.; sister-in-law, Deborah Jones; a host of cousins, nieces, nephews, and dear friends.

In every star's shimmer, your presence I know*

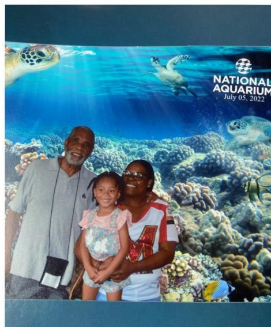
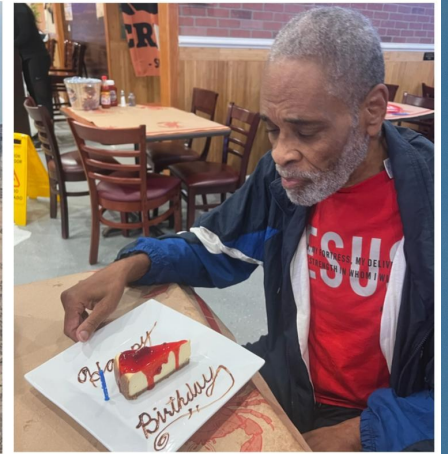
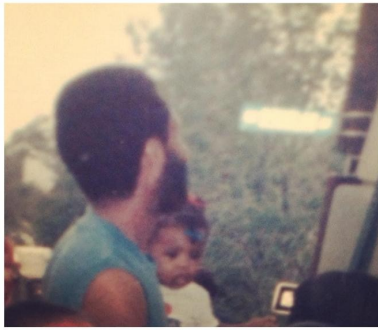
