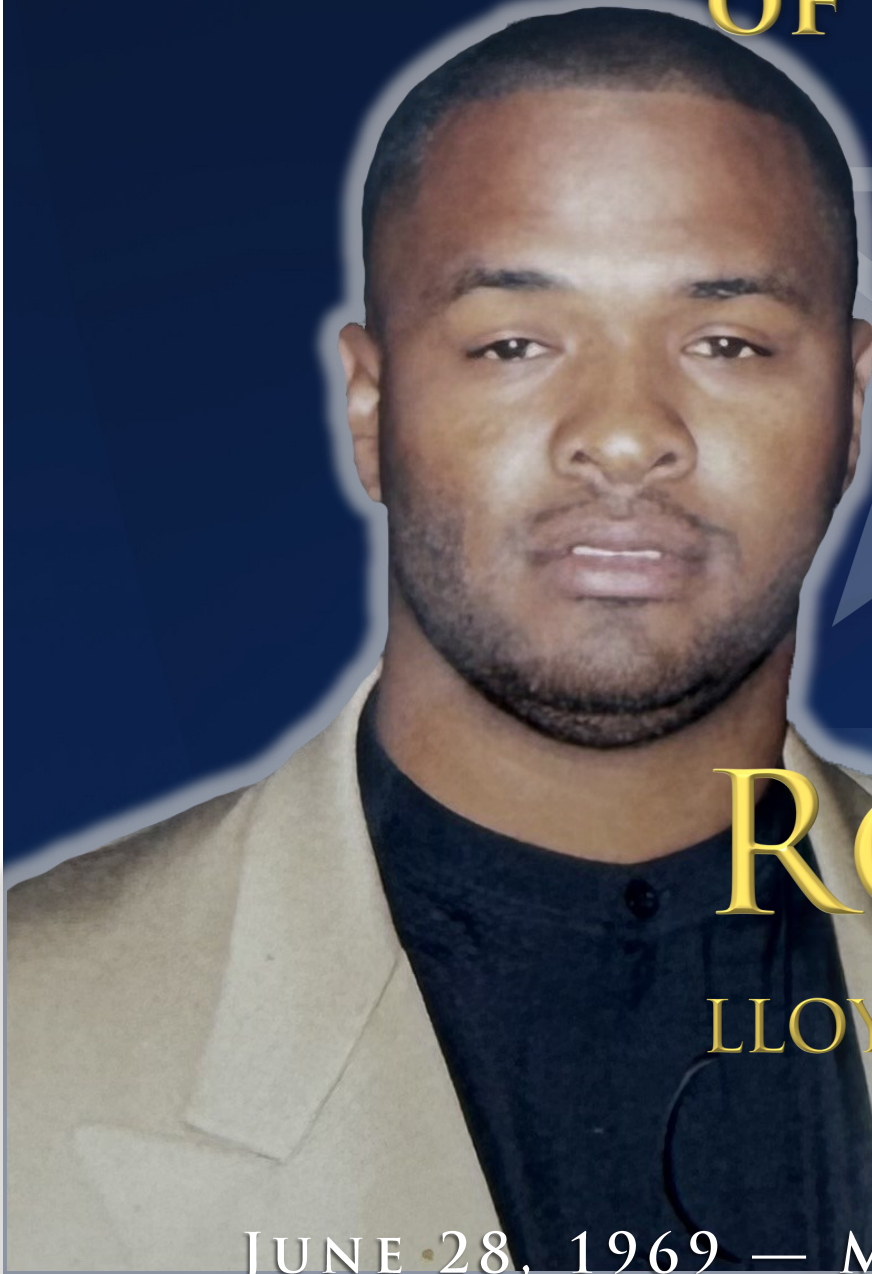

# OBITUARY

On June 28, 1969, Robert “Rob” Lloyd Bunch was born to the late Robert Lewis Bunch and the late Beverly Ann Bunch in Washington, DC. He had a twin brother, an older brother, and two sisters.

Rob was educated in the Prince George’s County public school system and graduated from Forestville High School. During his career, he worked at Mattress Discounters and various jobs within the federal government. Later, he jointly co-founded an investment group and formed a brotherhood alongside other like-minded individuals.

Rob was married to Tracy Walker and from that union one child was born. He was also a loving father to a beautiful daughter. His family was his life and he believed in encouraging others. He loved inviting family over for holiday gatherings and enjoyed hosting, playing games, laughing, and watching movies. His collection of movies and cd’s was ginormous! He coached basketball and football, and was always enthused about fundamentally training and enhancing his son’s skills in any sport. He also played sports in his youth.

Rob loved to travel with his family and did so frequently for family outings, Amateur Athletic Union (AAU) tournaments, track and field, and an array of other events. He loved people, had an abundance of friends, and never met a stranger. He enjoyed great conversations and networking was one of his strong attributes. Oftentimes, his children benefited from opportunities that were initiated from a conversation with friends or a random person.

Rob was a mama’s boy indeed but never wanted to admit it. The love they had for one another was unmatched. He called and/or visited her daily just to make sure she was doing okay and she did the same. During family time, laughter was always in the midst of good conversations, and she always prayed for the family.

Rob gave his life to Jesus Christ and joined From the Heart Church Ministries in 1993. He served in the Helps Ministry.

Rob leaves to cherish his memory his son, Robert “Raji”; daughter, Tiara; grandson, Gary; former wife, Tracy; brother, Roderick; sisters, Pamela and Gina; and a host of extended family and countless friends.

In addition to his parents, Rob was preceded in death by his older brother, Paul.

*Thank you for the good times we shared.*

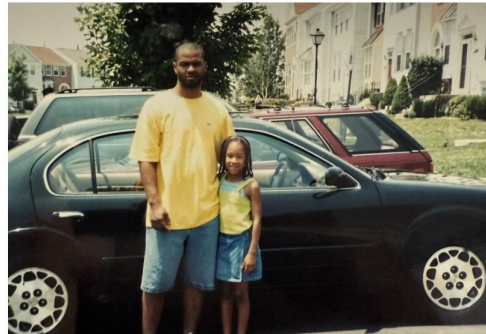
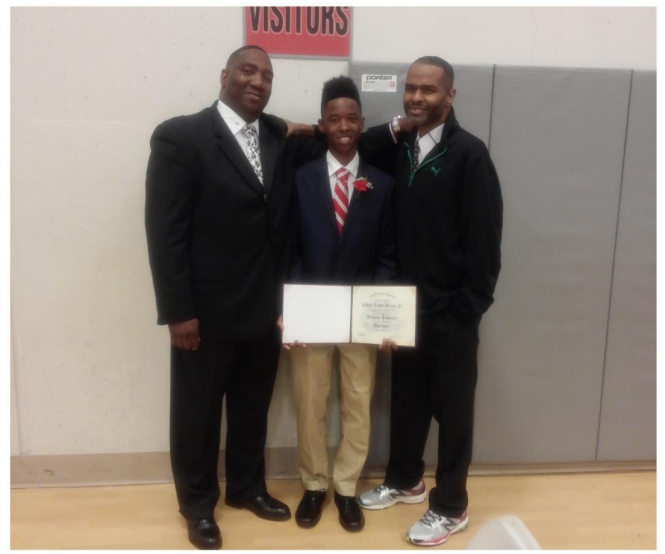
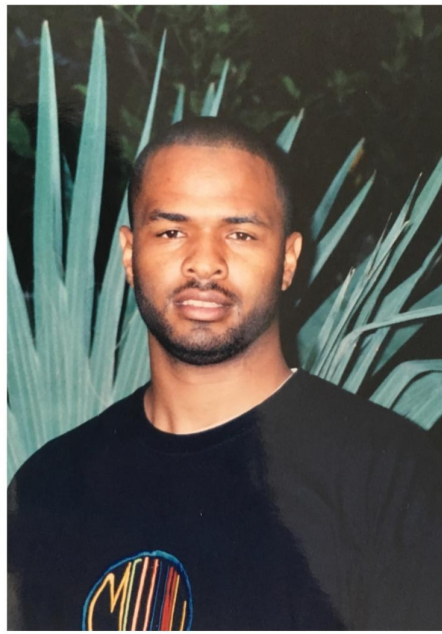
