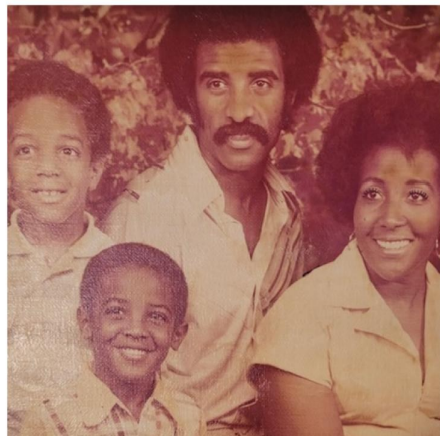
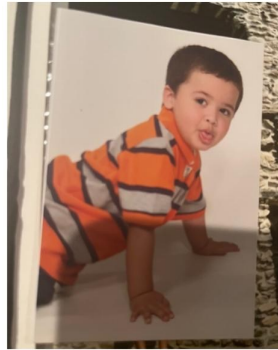
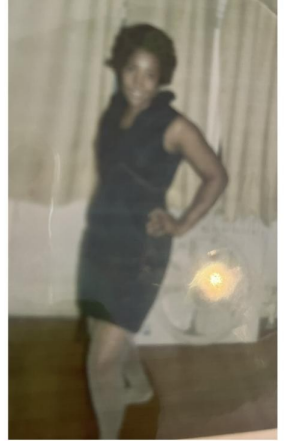
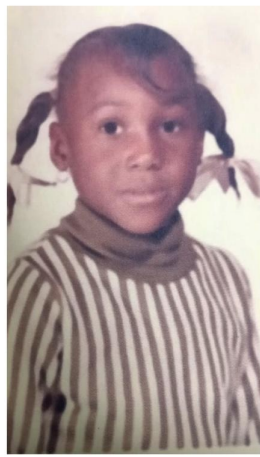
## ***Footprints in the Sand***

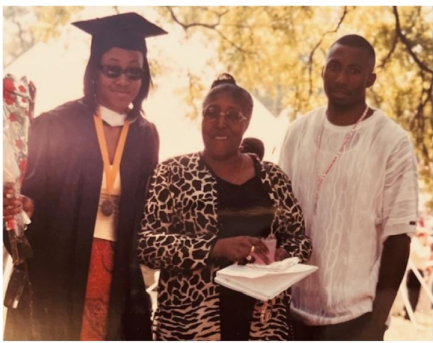
